What is the future of Haggerston Baths?

Haggerston Baths in Whiston Road E2 is a grade 2 listed building; opened in 1904, it was closed due to lack of funds in 2000, and local community members have campaigned since then to have it re-opened as a swimming pool, alongside community facilities. Financial pressures on the council have made this outcome look increasingly unlikely.

In April 2015 Hackney Council advertised the pool building on a long lease for redevelopment. 29 expressions of interest have been received.
